CHIO-Aachen horsefeed tested on absence of FEI-forbidden substances.

At CHIO Aachen, all riders can dispose of free horsefeed. Since 2004 the feed is supplied by HAVENS horsefeed-company from the Netherlands.

Especially for CHIO Aachen 2009, all available feeds will be tested on the absence of FEI-forbidden substances at HFL Sport Science (near Cambridge, England), one of the world's largest sport drug surveillance laboratories. (www.hfl.co.uk).

“In view of today's discussion on doping in the equestrian world, we want to be absolutely sure all CHIO-participants can rely for 100% on the feed,” says Havens-director Joris Kaanen. “We use HFL as it's probably the best feed-testing-lab in the world with some 20 years experience of horsefeed-testing for the British Jockey Club and the British Equestrian Federation.”

In total some 20.000 kilo of Havens horsefeed – cubes and mueslis - will be shipped to Aachen for the CHIO 2009.

Havens is specialised in high-performance horsefeed and was “official supplier” of the 2006 FEI World Equestrian Games in Aachen, the 2008 FEI World Endurance Championship in Malaysia as well as the 2008 FEI World Driving Championship and supplies feed for the Olympic Games since 1988.
